

Pricing Schedule

Effective August 1, 2009

Full Board **\$500 / month**

Full board is the full time care of your horse, including stalling, pasture time, twice a day stall cleaning, feed and hay. We provide a variety of feeds and will pick the best match and feeding regimen to maintain your horse's health and condition. If your horse requires supplementation we will be happy to include it in the feedings, but you must provide the supplements. Full board also grants you unlimited access to the riding facilities. Blanketing and fan fees are included. All boarding, leasing, and training bills will be sent out on the 26th, with payments being due the 5th of each month.

Leasing **Private Treaty**

Full Training **\$450/month**

Full training will include 4–5 sessions (training rides or lessons) per week and show quality grooming. Prior to the start of training we will create a list of goals for your horse and the training regimen will be directed toward obtaining those goals. While your horse is in training, we will maintain a show quality condition with continual grooming and maintenance.

**If over 5 rides/lessons are completed in a week additional lessons must be purchased*

Lessons

You may purchase these lessons individually or as a package. Individual lesson payment will be due prior to each lesson while package lesson payment will be due prior to the first lesson. Cancellation notice must be given 24 hours prior to the scheduled lesson or you will be charged for that lesson. If the instructor must cancel lessons due to weather or other events, the lesson will be rescheduled to your earliest convenience. Lessons may not carry over month to month.

Beginner lessons

\$35

Time of lessons will include grooming, tacking up, riding, and additional groundwork to increase riding competency and skills. Beginner lessons are designed to introduce new riders to the skills and techniques needed to become better riders and horsemen. Lessons may be given privately or in groups of 2 and last from 45 minutes to an hour.

Intermediate / Advanced lessons

Time of these lessons will include flat work, dressage, equitation and style exercises, strength building, and jumping. If jumping is not possible, additional work on the flat, riding technique, and horsemanship will take place.

Showing Price List

Throughout the year we will attend various horse shows. This sheet lists the costs you will incur for training, transportation, etc through the barn when attending these show, but does not include the fees and costs you will incur for the show itself. Horse show costs vary depending on the quality and duration of the show, but usually include office/management fees, entry fees, and stabling fees for overnight shows. Each show sends out a prize list that spells out these costs before the date of the show so that you know what costs to expect.

While the most important expectation at shows is that you have fun with your horse and your friends, there are a few other expectations that are in place to keep the experience safe and running smoothly. Unless otherwise provided for in your fees for the show, it is expected of you to provide continual care for your horse (which may include feeding and stall cleaning). Furthermore, it will be expected of you to have your horse and yourself show prepped (which means spotless) and ready to school/compete in a timely manner. For this to happen you must maintain communication with me and be aware of the show schedule so that you know when and where you need to be. Finally, it will be expected of you to provide support and cheer to your barnmates and to maintain a positive attitude throughout.

In addition to your expectations, there are also expectations of me as the trainer. The most important of these being that I will provide continuous supervision of you and your horses to ensure that a safe and friendly atmosphere is maintained. The care of your horses and your safety is my utmost priority both at home and away. Additionally, I will do my best to provide you with the information you need for you to be in the right place and the right time. Furthermore I will provide you with the coaching and support necessary to make your show experience as successful as it can be. Finally, I will maintain a positive and helpful attitude throughout the show and do my best to ensure that a friendly and positive atmosphere is maintained throughout our barn.

Training and Schooling Fee

\$60 per day

This fee includes any lessons or training rides while at the show to prepare for your classes. Also included in this fee is the overall supervision of your horses care during the show.

Horse Leasing for shows

Private Treaty

This fee applies when a horse is leased specifically for a show.

Transportation

\$.60 per mile

Total mileage will be calculated for trailering to the show and then split evenly amongst the horses trailered.

Trainer expenses

Show dependent

Applies to overnight shows, includes lodging and meals to be split evenly per horse.

Away Show Fee

\$50 per day

This fee applies to any show where I am unable to care for the horses at home and is split evenly per horse showing.
